## Board Of Education

Responsibility for overseeing the public schools lies with the Board of Education. This includes setting and maintaining policies, approving the annual school district budget, representing the community's educational philosophy, and evaluating the performance of the superintendent of schools.

Responsibility for day-to-day operations lies with the superintendent, and through him with the district's administrative, teaching, and support staff.

**AGENDAS:** Agendas are posted on the Board of Education website by 4pm on the Tuesday before the scheduled meeting.

**BUDGET:** Members of the community who wish to offer suggestions that will affect the budget are urged to contact the superintendent during the summer, when preliminary work on the budget begins.

Detailed development takes place in the fall. The superintendent meets with the board's Finance Committee in January. Discussions with the full board and members of the public begin in February. The preliminary budget is typically approved in March and posted on the district website. The budget is finalized in May.

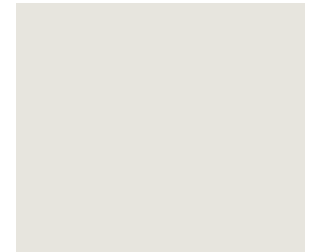

## School District

The Haddonfield School District operates a high school (grades 9 thru 12), middle school (grades 6 thru 8), and three elementary schools (grades K thru 5), with a total student population of approximately 2,650. Inclusive preschool services are provided for students from age 3.

For school district purposes, Haddonfield is divided into three neighborhoods – one for each elementary school. Elementary-age students in each neighborhood typically attend the elementary school in their neighborhood. Haddonfield is small enough in size that the district is not required to provide bus transportation for students attending the public schools in Haddonfield.

The operation of the district is overseen by the Board of Education. Responsibility for day-to-day operations lies with the superintendent of schools.

**LEASHES:** When you have a dog in your care in a public place, you **MUST** keep the dog on a leash.

**LICENSES:** If you own a cat or dog that's over six months old, you must obtain a license for it each year, by January 31.

Submit form, with fee and proof of rabies inoculation, at Borough Hall, Room 101; or by mail to 242 Kings Highway E.

Fees: Cats \$24 (\$17 if neutered); Dogs \$24 (\$21 if neutered). Late fees apply if paid after January 31.

**LOST PETS:** The designated Camden County shelter for pets found in Haddonfield is The Animal Orphanage, 419 Cooper Road, Voorhees. 627-9111.

## CHIPPING

At certain times of the year, the Borough chips tree limbs, branches, and Christmas trees, up to a maximum diameter of 6 inches. Branches should be placed loose, near the curb but not in the street. **BAMBOO:** Cannot be chipped. Bundle and tie as brush. See "Vegetative Waste". **CHRISTMAS TREES:** Remove all ornaments, tinsel, lights, etc. **DO NOT** place in a plastic bag.

**TREES, STUMPS:** The Borough does not pick up entire trees or stumps.

**TIMING:** From January through October, during the third full trash/recycle week of each month. Begins on the third Monday of the month, on regular trash/recycling day. In November and December chipping discontinued during leaf season. Large limbs should be kept away from the street and park strip during this time. See also under "Vegetative Waste" for alternative disposal information.

**RAKING: DO NOT RAKE LEAVES INTO GUTTER OR STREET.** Rake leaves in piles on park strip or, where there is no park strip, behind curb. **DO NOT** place leaves in plastic bags (ever!) or in paper bags during Leaf Collection season.

## MOSQUITO CONTROL

Mosquito bites can cause such serious diseases as Eastern Encephalitis and West Nile Fever. The first week of a mosquito's life is in water, so the management of water is the first line of defense.

Camden County cleans streams and ponds, stocks them with fish (which eat mosquito larvae), and investigates stagnant water conditions.

Residents can help inhibit the development of mosquito larvae by ensuring that water does not lie stagnant on their property. Check bird baths, open containers, watering cans, etc.

## OPEN HOUSES

Real estate open houses may not be held on Sunday. Signage is only allowed on the property the day of the open house. No balloons, lighting or sound generating equipment is allowed [see §191-18(A) (1-6)].

## PARKING

The parking of vehicles on public property in Haddonfield is regulated, and controlled by the Police Department.

The parking of vehicles in PATCO lots is controlled by the Delaware River Port Authority's Transit Police: 963-7995.

**FREE PARKING:** Parking in spaces regulated by meters and kiosks is free from 6pm to 2am, and on weekends.

**OVERNIGHT PARKING:** The parking of vehicles on streets between 2am and 5am is prohibited. Exceptions: When the homeowner's driveway is being paved; when there is insufficient room for an overnight guest's vehicle to be parked in the homeowner's driveway.

To register for temporary overnight parking, call 784-9161 x 7. The maximum number of requests permitted per month, per property or vehicle, is seven.

**PAID PARKING:** Most public parking spaces in the business district are regulated by timed meters and kiosks. Some spaces are regulated by permit.

**PERMITS:** Residents who are unable to park their vehicles on private property may obtain a permit to park in a Borough lot. Apply at the Police Department.

Business owners and their employees within the commercial district may apply for monthly permits at the Information Center.

**SNOW EMERGENCIES:** The Borough will not help dig out vehicles that have been plowed-in during a snow emergency.

## PASSPORTS

The Haddonfield Post Office does not accept passport applications. Apply at the Cherry Hill Post Office, Marlkrass Road, or at the County Store, Voorhees Town Center.

**CONSTRUCTION:** Permits are required for most types of work, so call to check!

- "Dumpsters" on the street
- Electrical work
- Fences
- Heating systems
- Hot tubs and saunas
- Lawn irrigation systems
- Plumbing
- Roofs and gutters
- Security systems
- Siding
- Smoke, heat, and radon detectors
- Container-type storage on the street
- Swimming pools.

Submit applications at the Community Development Office, Borough Hall, Room 104.

**OTHER: BUSINESSES & PROFESSIONAL** Business owners and professionals (or their landlords) must obtain permits for:

- Installing permanent signs on buildings and in windows
- Displaying merchandise outdoors
- Placing tables, chairs, and menu boards outside restaurants.

**OTHER: COMMERCIAL**

Taxis, solicitors, and peddlers (except military veterans) must obtain permits to ply in Haddonfield.

**OTHER: RESIDENTIAL**

Residents must obtain permits for:

- Block parties
- Garage and yard sales
- Parking in certain designated spaces in Borough lots.

## PROPERTY TAXES

The Borough levies and collects taxes on most real property in the Borough. Exempt properties include those owned by government and religious entities.

Tax bills are mailed to property owners and mortgage companies in July.

Property tax bills for residential properties have six components:

- County tax
- County Open Space tax
- School tax
- Local Purpose (municipal) tax
- Library tax
- Municipal Open Space tax.

Tax bills for commercial properties also include a Special Improvement District assessment.

Periodically, the Borough forwards the taxes it collects on behalf of other entities. The Borough must pay 100% of the taxes owed, even if it has not received the full amount.

Property taxes are payable quarterly, on or before Feb 1, May 1, Aug 1, and Nov 1. Property taxes that are payable directly to the Borough may be paid online, by mail, or at the Borough Hall, Room 105.

The Borough charges interest on payments that are overdue.

**RECYCLE OR TRASH?** A poster that shows clearly what to recycle and what to trash is available at [http://haddonfieldnj.org/departments/public\\_works/garbage\\_trash\\_and\\_recycling.php](http://haddonfieldnj.org/departments/public_works/garbage_trash_and_recycling.php). The recycling of certain materials is mandated by state, county, and municipal law. Such materials include aluminum, cardboard, certain electronic items, glass, paper, certain plastics, tin.

For recycling-collection purposes, the Borough is divided into five districts, one for each day of the week.

Trash and recycling are collected on the same day. See the back cover of this calendar for specific holidays.

**CONTAINERS:** Red and blue recycling cans provided by the Borough may be used interchangeably. Cans may be purchased at the Public Works facility, 555 Centre Street, for \$10 each.

**ELECTRONIC ITEMS:** Put out on regular trash/recycling days, but separately from trash and regular recycling materials.

A list of electronic items that should be recycled is on the Borough website.

- Rechargeable batteries should be recycled; regular batteries go in the trash.
- Electronic items may be recycled at Goodwill, on Grove Street.

**MEDICATION:** The Police Department accepts and safely disposes of unwanted and out-of-date medication.

**PERSONAL PAPERS:** See "Shredding Event."

**PLACEMENT:** In the residential district, recycling containers should be placed on the "park strip" (between the sidewalk and the curb) after 1pm on the day prior to collection and before 7am on the day of collection.

In the business district, recycling containers should be placed on the sidewalk after 5pm on the day before collection and before 6am on the day of collection.

**DO NOT** place recycling and recycling containers in the street.

**65 CLUB:** A social club for retired male residents meets each Thursday at 1:30pm at 110 Rhoads Avenue (a Borough property).

**ACTIVITIES** for seniors at the Mabel Kay Senior Center include bridge, bingo, cardio fun, lite aerobics, line dancing, tai chi, art workplace, and computer club.

**EVENTS** for seniors at the Mabel Kay Senior Center each year include Valentine Party, Summer Cookout, Thanksgiving Party, and Holiday Party.

**FOOD:** A Dire Need Food Shelf is maintained at the Mabel Kay Senior Center. Some congregations also accept donations of food and clothing.

**HOT WEATHER RELIEF:** On days when the temperature is expected to exceed 90°, the Mabel Kay Senior Center is open from 10am to 4pm.

**HOUSING:** Housing for seniors at or below 50% of area median income is provided at Tarditi Commons, a three-story building with 48 one-bedroom units located at 325 Lincoln Avenue.

When having new sidewalk laid at your property, if tree roots from a borough tree need attention, call Public Works at 429-0183 x 0 to schedule this work. This work **MUST** be approved or performed by Public Works. Note – this service is only scheduled for Thursdays.

## SIGNS

**No signs OF ANY KIND may be placed on public property.** This includes the "park strip" between sidewalk and curb, trees, and utility poles.

Merchants, restaurateurs, and other business owners **MUST** check with the Zoning Office **BEFORE** installing signs. Permits are required!

## SPRING CLEAN-OUT

See also "Chipping," "Recycling," "Trash," "Vegetative Waste."

In the spring – starting with the first full week of April and running for four weeks – the Borough facilitates the cleaning out of residential attics, basements, garages and yards by relaxing the 6 piece per residence weekly garbage limit. All items placed curbside must meet the requirements for proper weekly placement of trash.

**LEAVES:** Leaves and other yard debris may be piled in the park strip (between the curb and the sidewalk). They do not need to be in containers. Leaves will be collected during the second and fourth weeks of the Clean-Out period.

**TREE LIMBS, BRANCHES:** Will be chipped during the first and third weeks of the Clean-Out period.

## SNOW

**SALTING:** When warranted, the Borough spreads sand and/or salt on streets and county roads in Haddonfield in advance of snow and ice storms. **PLOWING:** The Borough plows snow on streets, county roads in Haddonfield, and public parking lots after at least 2 to 3 inches of snow have fallen.

The Borough does not clear snow that accumulates in private driveways when the streets are plowed. Suggestion: Wait until the street has been plowed curb-to-curb before shoveling snow from driveways.

The Borough does not clear snow that accumulates around vehicles that have been left on streets or in parking lots. Suggestion: When heavy snow is forecast, move vehicles from streets and parking lots to private property.

**REMOVAL:** Owners of commercial properties must remove snow and ice from public sidewalks abutting their property within 18 hours of falling snow or forming of ice.

**SNOW EMERGENCY:** The state, county, and Borough may declare a "snow emergency" when circumstances warrant. When a snow emergency has been declared, residents must move their vehicles from the streets and Borough lots. The Borough does not assist those whose vehicles have been plowed in.

**VEHICLES:** Prior to the first snowfall each year, those who have permits to park their vehicles on the street overnight or in Borough parking lots should make arrangements to park their vehicles on private property instead, whenever a snow emergency is declared. **DRIVEWAYS & SIDEWALKS:** Property owners should wait until their street has been plowed curb-to-curb before shoveling snow from driveway aprons. The Borough does not remove snow from driveways that have been plowed-in by snowplows.

See back cover of this calendar for specific holidays. **BULK ITEMS:**

- Appliances, furniture, mattresses, etc. must fit in an 8ft pickup truck and be able to be lifted safely by two men.
- Carpet: Roll in pieces no longer than 4ft and no heavier than 50lbs.
- Refrigerators: Remove doors.
- Scrap wood: cut to 4ft lengths and tied in 50lb. bundles.

**COMPOSTING:** The Borough encourages the composting of biodegradable materials. For advice, contact Sustainable Haddonfield: 429-4700 x 321. **CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:** The Borough **DOES NOT** collect debris from construction projects. Such material must be disposed of at a state-approved sanitary landfill by the contractor or homeowner.

Permit forms for the Pennsauken Landfill are available at the Borough Hall, Room 104. Questions? Call 429-4700 x 224. **CONTAINERS:** Trash should be placed either in (a) metal or plastic cans with lids, maximum capacity 32 gallons; or (b) heavy-duty plastic bags, minimum thickness 1.3 mil.

Trash placed in paper bags, cardboard boxes, containers larger than 32 gallons, bushel baskets, or metal or plastic tubs **WILL NOT** be picked up.

**DIRT, STONE, & MASONRY PRODUCTS:** **WILL NOT** be collected by the Borough. See: "Construction Debris," above.

**DUMPSTERS & PODS:** Before placing a large trash receptacle or storage container in the street, apply for a permit at the Zoning Office, Room 104.

**FOOD WASTE:** If possible, compost. If not, place in paper or plastic bags **inside a covered metal or plastic can.** **PLACEMENT:** In the residential district, trash containers should be placed on the "park strip" (between the sidewalk and the curb) between 1pm on the day prior to collection and 7am on the day of collection.

In the business district, trash containers should be placed on the sidewalk between 5pm on the day before collection and 6:00am on the day of collection.

**DO NOT** place trash containers in the street.

**QUANTITY:** No more than six items per residence per week may be placed for collection.

**SIZE AND WEIGHT:** Except for bulk items, no single item may weigh more than 50lbs at time of collection.

## SEWER BLOCKAGES

If your sanitary sewer is blocked, call New Jersey American Water **BEFORE** you call a plumber! 800-272-1325. Personnel are on duty 24/7.

## TREES

The planting, care, and removal of trees in parks and along streets trees is overseen by the Shade Tree Commission. Some 9,500 trees are maintained by the Public Works Department and contractors retained by the Borough.

New trees are planted each year to replace those that have died or become damaged or diseased. Existing trees are trimmed for appearance or safety reasons. **COMMEMORATIVE TREES:** For details of the program under which trees may be planted in someone's memory or honor, go to [haddonfieldnj.org/boards\\_and\\_committees/shade\\_tree\\_commission/commemorative\\_tree\\_donation\\_program.php](http://haddonfieldnj.org/boards_and_committees/shade_tree_commission/commemorative_tree_donation_program.php)

The minimum donation is \$1,000.

This covers the cost of the tree and commemorative plaque, as well as planting and maintenance.

**FALLEN TREES & BRANCHES:** To report a tree or large branch that has fallen on public property, call the Public Works Department: 429-0183 x 0.

If a tree or branch has fallen on power, telephone, or cable lines **DO NOT** touch the tree or branch. Call Police Dispatch: 429-3000. If possible, remain in the vicinity to alert others to the potential danger. **ROOTS:** When having new sidewalk laid at your property, if tree roots from a borough tree need attention, call Public Works at 429-0183, ext. 0 to schedule this work. This work **MUST** be approved or performed by DPW. Note – this service is only scheduled for Thursdays.

**PLANTING, TRIMMING, & REMOVING TREES:** **ONLY** those acting under the direction of the Shade Tree Commission may plant, trim, maintain, or remove trees on public property. Others may be summoned to appear in Municipal Court, and may be fined.

## VEGETATIVE WASTE

See also "Chipping," "Spring Clean-Out," "Recycling," "Trash."

**GRASS CLIPPINGS:** The Borough advocates the "cut-it-and-leave-it" approach and therefore urges residents and lawn contractors to use mulching mowers. Landscapers **MUST** remove grass clippings from lawns they cut.

**TREE LIMBS, BRANCHES, BRUSH:**

When chipping is not possible, either tie in a bundle of no more than 50 pounds and 4 feet in length; or place in an approved container.

**CONTAINERS:** Plastic bags **MUST NOT** be used for vegetative waste. Instead use:

- Green veg cans provided by the Borough. Cans may be purchased at the Public Works facility, 555 Centre Street, for \$10 each.
- Open containers with a Borough supplied yellow sticker on them. (Stickers are available at Public Works and Borough Hall Room 101.)
- Compostable paper bags.

A container must not weigh more than 50 pounds at the time of collection. Since grass will absorb moisture and weigh more after it is placed in a container, do not place too much in each bag or can.

## TIMING:

- From the first full week of April into October, on regular trash/recycling day.
- From November thru March, during the first full trash/recycling week of each month. Begins on the first Monday of the month, on regular trash/recycling day.

## VITAL RECORDS

The State of New Jersey requires that certain "vital events" – births, births resulting in stillbirths, adoptions, marriages, domestic partnerships, and deaths – be registered with the state.

Copies of vital records may be obtained from the NJ Office of Vital Statistics and Registry – [state.nj.us/health/vital/](http://state.nj.us/health/vital/) – and from the registrar of the municipality in which the event took place.

## WATER & SEWER UTILITY

Haddonfield's water and sewer system is owned and maintained by New Jersey American Water. Bills for water and sewer use are sent to customers by NJ American Water. Customers should make payments directly to them.

Emergency service is available around-the-clock. Call 800-272-1325.

To set up an online account, go to [www.amwater.com/myh2o](http://www.amwater.com/myh2o) and register using your account number (which is printed on your paper bill). With an online account, you will be able to track your water usage, pay your bill, sign up for paperless billing, and access information about NJ American Water and the services they provide.

## WATER USE

The Borough encourages residents and business owners to conserve water. In particular, the Borough discourages the use of sprinkler systems to water lawns on hot days.

In the spring, the Commissioners adopt an ordinance that defines three levels of mandatory restrictions they may enforce during the summer months, if warranted. For details, visit the Borough website.

## YARD & GARAGE SALES

Residents may hold one sale in any six-month period. Sales are not permitted on Sunday.

Apply in person at Borough Hall, Room 101. The fee is \$5. The penalty for conducting a sale without a permit is \$10, plus the \$5 permit fee.

Signs are permitted only on property where the sale is being conducted. **Signs MUST NOT be placed on poles, trees, or in the Borough right-of-way.**
