Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that an individual at Elizabeth Haddon has tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Contact tracers will be using timelines based on the onset of symptoms and dates of positive test results. If there are individuals identified as close-contacts, whether the contacts happened in school or elsewhere, they will be notified by the Camden County Department of Health, most likely within the next 24-48 hours.

We continue to urge parents to keep your student home at the first signs of [COVID symptoms](#) and to please notify your school nurse as soon as you receive a COVID+ test. This helps the school district to respond in the most efficient manner possible.

Here are all of the details that we are permitted to share at this time:

Case 48: Haddon

- The individual is a juvenile female (under 10) in Cohort B.
- The individual is asymptomatic.
- The individual was tested and received a positive test on Wednesday, December 2. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days prior to either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days prior to symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Monday, November 30.
- This individual was last in school on Tuesday, November 24.
- Based on currently available information, this individual did not likely contract the virus in school.
