

**@HSDHealth Message Five Individuals Test Positive:
2 females HMHS, 1 female Central, 1 male Central, 1 male HMS**

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that (5) individuals in the Haddonfield School District have tested positive for COVID-19. Most all contact tracing has been completed (new case reported during the writing of this notice).

We continue to urge parents to keep your student home at the first signs of [COVID symptoms](#) and to please notify your school nurse as soon as you receive a COVID+ test. This helps the school district respond in the most efficient manner possible.

Here are all of the details that we are permitted to share at this time:

Case 80: HMHS

- The individual is a female in her 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Wednesday, December 16.
- The individual was tested on Friday, December 18, and received results on Saturday, December 19. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Monday, December 14.
- This individual was last in the district on Monday/Tuesday, December 14-15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unclear whether this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 81: HMHS

- The individual is a female in her 10s in Cohort B.
- The individual was asymptomatic.
- The individual was tested on Friday, December 18, and received results on Monday, December 21. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Wednesday, December 16.
- This individual was last in the district on Friday, November 13.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 82: Central

- The individual is a juvenile female (under 10) in the All-Virtual model.
- The individual was asymptomatic.
- The individual was tested on Saturday, December 19, and received results on Monday, December 21. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, December 17.
- This individual has not been in the school district since she is in the all-virtual model.

- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 83: Central

- The individual is a juvenile male (under 10) in the All-Virtual model.
- The individual was asymptomatic.
- The individual was tested on Saturday, December 19, and received results on Monday, December 21. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, December 17.
- This individual has not been in the school district since he is in the all-virtual model.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 84: HMS

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, December 14.
- The individual was tested on Saturday, December 19, and received results on Monday, December 21. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, December 12.
- This individual was last in the district on Monday, December 14.
- Based on currently available information, it is unclear whether this individual contracted the virus in school.
