Inclement Weather

N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9, P.L.2020, c.27 (A3904)

Because we are still under a public health emergency, school districts can provide remote instruction in lieu of a snow day this year. When we are no longer under this public health emergency, the authorization to use virtual/remote instruction in lieu of a snow day will only apply if the district is closed for more than three consecutive school days due to a declared state of emergency, declared public health emergency, or a directive by the appropriate health agency or officer to institute a public health-related closure, per N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-9, P.L.2020, c.27 (A3904). 




