

@HSDHealth Message Nine Individuals Test Positive: 1 female at Elizabeth Haddon, 1 male at Tatem, 3 males and 3 females at HMS, 1 female Tatem/HMHS staff person.

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that nine (9) individuals from the Haddonfield School District have tested positive for COVID-19.

We continue to urge parents to keep your student home at the first signs of [COVID symptoms](#) and to please notify your school nurse as soon as you receive a COVID+ test. This helps the school district respond in the most efficient manner possible. None of these cases required in-district contact tracing.

Here are all of the details that we are permitted to share at this time:

Case 86: Elizabeth Haddon

- The individual is a juvenile female (under 10) in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, December 21.
- The individual was tested and received results on Wednesday, December 23. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, December 19.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 87: Tatem

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort B.
- The individual was symptomatic on Saturday, December 19.
- The individual was tested on Monday, December 21, and received results on Friday, December 25. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, December 17.
- This individual was last in the district on Wednesday, December 16.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 88: HMS

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort B.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, December 21.
- The individual was tested and received results on Wednesday, December 23. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, December 19.
- This individual was last in the district on Friday, December 11.

- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 89: HMS

- The individual is a female in her 10s in Cohort B.
- The individual was symptomatic on Thursday, December 24.
- The individual was tested on Saturday, December 26, and received results on Monday, December 28. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Tuesday, December 22.
- This individual was last in the district on Friday, December 11.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 90: Tatem/HMHS

- The individual is a female in her 30s.
- The individual was symptomatic on Friday, December 25.
- The individual was tested and received results on Tuesday, December 29. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Wednesday, December 23.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 91: HMS

- The individual is a female in her 40s.
- The individual was symptomatic on Thursday, December 31.
- The individual was tested on Saturday, January 2, and received results on Sunday, January 3. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Tuesday, December 29.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unclear whether this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 92: HMS

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Saturday, December 19.
- The individual was tested and received results on Tuesday, December 22. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, December 17.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 93: HMS

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Wednesday, December 30.
- The individual was tested and received results on Tuesday, December 22. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Sunday, December 20.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 8.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 94: HMS

- The individual is a female in her 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Wednesday, December 30.
- The individual was tested and received results on Thursday, December 31. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Sunday, December 20.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely that this individual contracted the virus in school.
