

**@HSDHealth Message** Six Individuals Test Positive: 1 HMHS male, 1 Central female staff, 1 Central female, 1 HMHS male staff, 1 District female staff, 1 HMS male.

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that six (6) individuals in the Haddonfield School District have tested positive for COVID-19. All contact tracing has been completed.

We continue to urge parents to keep your student home at the first signs of [COVID symptoms](#) and to please notify your school nurse as soon as you receive a COVID+ test. This helps the school district respond in the most efficient manner possible.

Here are all of the details that we are permitted to share at this time:

**Case 95: HMHS**

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Saturday, December 26.
- The individual was tested and received results on Sunday, December 27. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, December 24.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 8.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

**Case 96: Central**

- The individual is a female in her 20s.
- The individual was symptomatic, tested, and received results on Monday, January 4.
- According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, January 2.
- This individual was last in the district on Wednesday, December 23.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

**Case 97: Central**

- The individual is a juvenile female (under 10) in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Sunday, December 27. She was tested and received results on Monday, December 28.
- According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Friday, December 25.
- This individual was last in the district on Tuesday, December 8.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

#### Case 98: HMHS

- The individual is a male in his 50s.
- The individual was asymptomatic.
- The individual was tested on Saturday, January 2 and received results on Monday, January 4. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, December 31.
- This individual was last in the district on Friday, December 18.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

#### Case 99: District Personnel

- The individual is a female in her 60s.
- The individual was symptomatic on Wednesday, December 23.
- The individual was tested and received results on Friday, December 25. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Monday, December 21.
- This individual was last in the district on Friday, December 18.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

#### Case 100: HMS

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort A.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, January 4.
- The individual was tested and received results on Tuesday, January 5. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, January 2.
- This individual was last in the district on Monday, January 4.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.
