Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that an individual at Haddonfield Middle School has tested positive for COVID-19. All contact tracing has been completed.

We continue to urge parents to keep their students home at the first signs of [COVID symptoms](#) and to please notify your school nurse as soon as you receive a COVID+ test. This helps the school district respond in the most efficient manner possible.

Here are all of the details that we are permitted to share at this time:

Case 104: Middle

- **The individual is a female in her 30s.**
- **The individual was symptomatic on Thursday, January 7.**
- **The individual was tested on Friday, January 8, and received results on Sunday, January 9. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Tuesday, January 5.**
- **This individual was last in the district on Thursday, January 7.**
- **Based on currently available information, it is unclear whether this individual contracted the virus in school.**
