Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff:

This letter is to inform you that eight (8) individuals in the Haddonfield School District have tested positive for COVID-19. All contact tracing has been completed.

We continue to urge parents to keep their student home at the first signs of [COVID symptoms](#) and to please notify your school nurse as soon as you receive a COVID+ test. This helps the school district respond in the most efficient manner possible.

Here are all of the details that we are permitted to share at this time:

Case 109: Haddon

- The individual is a female in her 20s.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, January 11.
- The individual was tested Wednesday, January 13, and received results on Friday, January 15. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, January 9.
- This individual was last in the district on Wednesday, December 16.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 110: Tatem

- The individual is a juvenile (under 10) female in Cohort B.
- The individual was symptomatic and tested on Tuesday, January 12.
- The individual received results on Friday, January 15. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Sunday, January 10.
- This individual was last in the district on Monday, December 14.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 111: Tatem

- The individual is a male in his 10s in Cohort B.
- The individual was symptomatic and tested on Tuesday, January 12.
- The individual received results on Friday, January 15. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive

test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Sunday, January 10.

- This individual was last in the district on Monday, December 14.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 112: Haddon

- The individual is a juvenile (under 10) female in Cohort B.
- The individual was symptomatic on Thursday, January 14.
- The individual was tested Friday, January 15, and received results on Saturday, January 16. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Tuesday, January 12.
- This individual was last in the district on Thursday, January 14
- Based on currently available information, it is probable that this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 113: Tatem

- The individual is a female in her 10s in the all-virtual cohort.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, January 4.
- The individual was tested Tuesday, January 12, and received results on Wednesday, January 13. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, January 2.
- This individual was last in the district on Monday, December 14.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 114: Tatem

- The individual is a juvenile (under 10) male in the all-virtual cohort.
- The individual was symptomatic on Monday, January 4.
- The individual was tested Tuesday, January 12, and received results on Wednesday, January 13. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Saturday, January 2.
- This individual was last in the district on Monday, December 14.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 115: Haddon

- The individual is a female in her 10s in Cohort B.
- The individual was asymptomatic.
- The individual was tested Saturday, January 16, and received results on Sunday, January 17. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Thursday, January 14.

- This individual was last in the district on Friday, January 15.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.

Case 116: HMHS

- The individual is a female in her 40s.
- The individual was symptomatic and tested on Tuesday, January 12.
- The individual received results on Sunday, January 17. According to guidelines, there is a “look back” period beginning two days before either the administration of a positive test if asymptomatic or two days before symptoms with a positive test. In this case, the “look back” is Sunday, January 10.
- This individual was last in the district on Friday, January 8.
- Based on currently available information, it is unlikely this individual contracted the virus in school.
