

Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Breakdown

- The purpose of the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights (ABR) is to improve a school district's response to harassment, intimidation, bullying (HIB)
- It was put into law in 2011 and has been amended numerous times, with the most recent being in January 2022
- It establishes clearer standards for the definition of HIB
- Clarifies standards on preventing, reporting, investigating and responding to HIB incidents
- Encourages promoting a positive school climate
- Aims to reduce the risk of suicide.
